## Terms &amp; Conditions

**THE HEINEKEN REGATTA – ST. MAARTEN, CARIBBEAN**  
**February 28 – March 8, 2010**

It has been a pleasure planning this event and we are excited to host this regatta experience for you. Below are the points of agreement for the program:

1. This regatta program is offered to intermediate and advanced sailors (participants must be 21 years of age or older).
2. Regatta participation fees are \$3,650 per person.
3. 50% deposit due upon registration with final payment due 90 days prior to event.
4. SafePassageSailing (SPS) will provide two boats for this event: one (1) Farr 65 and one (1) Farr 40.7, and requisite safety equipment for the sailing program in accordance with the regatta schedule.
5. SPS will provide shore-side and on-water management for the program; program includes race entry and mooring fees, fuel, racing equipment on boat, SPS hats and shirts.
6. SPS will provide a continental breakfast, lunch, variety of snacks, water and other beverages daily for participants. Dinners are "on you own" and incidental costs are the responsibility of participants.
7. There will be up to 14 participants on the Farr 65 plus professional crew; up to 8 participants on the Farr 40.7 plus professional crew.
8. Participants have the option of staying aboard for the duration of the event (included in the event package); those who prefer land accommodations will be responsible for arranging their own accommodations and associated expenses. On board accommodations are follows:
  - **Farr 65:** 12 bunk accommodations w/lea cloths, 2 heads/showers, with shore facilities close by, and full galley. Sheets will be provided for each bunk. Participants should plan to bring a travel pillow and quick dry towels.
  - **Farr 40.7:** Accommodations on the Farr 40.7 consists of 3 double/shared cabins and 2 side berths. Each boat will supply sheets for bunks, two heads/showers and full galley.
9. Participants are responsible for bringing their own appropriate "gear" including rain protection, non marking deck shoes, sunscreen, sailing type clothing, travel pillow, quick dry towel/s.
10. All air and ground transportation costs are the responsibility of the participant.
11. Each participant will be required to sign a risk waiver at time of final payment stating that you understand that your participation in the regatta activities may involve certain risks or hazards; you understand that SPS has taken precautions to provide appropriate equipment and qualified on-shore and on-water management for this program; however, it is impossible for SPS to guarantee absolute safety within a sailing environment. You understand that you share and accept the responsibility for safety during the regatta activities, and agree to comply with the instructions and directions of SPS staff and representatives during the regatta.
12. Photographs taken during the regatta may be used in future marketing and promotional efforts.
13. Company reserves the right to screen all applicants regarding boating experience, any health issues, dietary needs, etc.
14. In the event of severe weather conditions which forces cancellation of the event, event fees will be prorated and credited to the participant for a future event.

**DEPOSITS & CANCELLATION TERMS**

1. Failure to make timely payment of the final amount 90 days prior to the event may result in the cancellation of the reservation and refund of deposit less 30% of the total package cost.
2. For written cancellation via email, receipt confirmed the following terms apply:
  - Prior to 90 days of event: SPS will refund moneys paid less 20% of program fee collected;
  - Between 90 days and 60 days prior to event: SPS will refund total package cost less 30%;
  - Within 60 days of the start of the event: SPS will refund monies paid less 50% of the total program fee.
3. Should Participant cancel but wish to register for another SPS program, SPS will apply monies paid less 20% of cancelled program fee to the cost of that future program.
4. Travel insurance is recommended for all international events and may be purchased through companies such as Travel Guard ([www.travelguard.com](http://www.travelguard.com)), CSA ([www.csatravelprotection.com](http://www.csatravelprotection.com)), etc.
